**AN ACT TO SANCTION CERTAIN PAYMENTS FROM
THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF DOMINICA
IN EXCESS OF THE SUM PROVIDED BY LAW
FOR THE SERVICES OF THE COMMON-
WEALTH OF DOMINICA DURING THE YEAR
ENDING THE THIRTIETH DAY OF JUNE 2009.**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Commonwealth of
Dominica as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the -

Short title.

**SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION
(2008/2009) (No. 2) ACT 2009.**

Legalisation of
unforeseen expenditure.

2. (1) The sum of thirty-six million, eight hundred and twenty nine thousand, eight hundred and fifty four dollars and two cents (\$36,829,854.02) as described in the Schedule was withdrawn from the Consolidated Fund of Dominica during the financial year ending on the 30th day of June, 2009.

(2) The sum specified in subsection (1) was used to defray unforeseen government expenditure in anticipation of a grant being made by the House of Assembly authorising the issue of the specified sum of money from the Consolidated Fund of Dominica.

(3) The sum specified in subsection (1) was lawfully withdrawn from the 1st day of July, 2008 and appropriated to the services set out in the Schedule.
