**SOCIAL SECURITY (SELF-EMPLOYED
PERSONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009.**

2. In these Regulations the Social Security (Self-Employed
Persons) Regulation is referred to as the “Principal Regulations”.

Interpretation
S.R.O 3 of 1989

3. Regulation 4(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by
inserting a comma immediately after the words ‘survivor’s
benefit’ and deleting the words “and medical benefit” and replacing
them with the following words “sickness benefit and maternity
benefit”.

4. Regulation 14 (a) of the Principal Regulations is amended
by deleting paragraph (a) and replacing it with the following:

“(a) A self-employed person may be exempted from the
liability to pay contributions under these Regulations
when he is in receipt of, or deemed to be in receipt of
an income which is below the minimum wage
prescribed for the time being under the Labour
Standards (Minimum Wage) Order, for an employee
in the same category of work.

Amendment of the
Second Schedule of the
Principal Regulations

5. The Second Schedule of the Principal Regulations as amended by SRO 10 of 2007 is amended in paragraph (b) by deleting the figure and sign “9.65%” and replacing it with the figure and sign “10 %”.

6. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st day of January, 2009.
