CHAPTER 1:13

ATTORNEY GENERAL (OFFICE OF MINISTER)  
(DESIGNATION) ACT

AN ACT to provide for the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister to designate the office of Attorney General to be the office of a Minister. 15 of 1978.

[26th October 1978]

Commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the –

Short Title.

ATTORNEY GENERAL (OFFICE OF MINISTER)  
(DESIGNATION) ACT.

2. In keeping with the provisions of section 71 (4) of the Constitution the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may by Order published in the *Gazette* designate the office of Attorney General to be the office of a Minister.
